

## About Eastern Shores, VA

The Fastern Shore of Virginia, and the town of Onancock in particular, offers a historic setting, a serene lifestyle and abundant outdoor recreation. Fishing and bird-watching are popular pastimes for both residents and visitors. The economy is largely agricultural, dominated by cotton, sovbean and vegetable farms and large-scale chicken farms. Farm and factory jobs have drawn a large number of Hispanic immigrants to this area, bringing a unique cultural influence and dynamic. However, some local residents experience the common rural struggle of unemployment. Another challenge has come from a large number of retirees moving to this beautiful area, causing home prices to increase and diminishing affordable housing options for those with lower incomes
